## 1. Introduction

In Torremolinos 1990, a recommendation (Torremolinos 1990 – C4.3) was adopted where publicity for usage of 10 MHz band is recommended, ***“It is recommended that*** publicity should be given to the 10 MHz band by way of activity days, DX-weekends articles etc. (Torremolinos 1990 - C4.3)”

In Torremolinos 1990, a recommendation (Torremolinos 1990 – C4.4) was adopted where publicity for usage of 18 and 24 MHz band is recommended, ***“It is recommended that*** publicity should be given to the 18 and 24 MHz bands by way of activity days, DX weekend, articles etc. (Torremolinos 1990 - C4.4)”

## 2. Situation

It is believed that due availability of amateur radio equipment, where 10, 18 and 24 MHz bands are one of the available bands, extra publicity for usage of 10, 18 and 24 MHz band is not necessary any more.

## 3. Recommendation

1. Due to already recognized amateur activities on 10 MHz it is proposed that this recommendation could be deleted.
2. Due to already recognized amateur activities on 18 and 24 MHz it is proposed that this recommendation could be deleted.
